write a poem to your childhood self about your biggest adventure to date

write the journey your name took to meet you

write a poem about the last thing you said to the person you love

write a morning prayer, invocation, or manifestation to start the day

write a poem from the perspective of your favourite animal or creature for a day

write an anthem to your imperfect body

coin a theory of human behaviour and show an example

free write for 10 minutes on the imagery of a tree that you Google

write a list of 13 songs they would play at your parade and why

write an ode to one day in your life from start to finish and let it sing

write a poem about a time you felt broken down, and pinpoint with your senses what struggle manifested as

write the opposite of a eulogy

write the song of a flower that will grow in your wake

what are you angry about? write your manifesto against injustice

write a poem set in the future – any future – about the big challenge of the day

write about grief as a hunger, and how you feed it

write about love as a vocation or a calling, and what it demands of you

FREE DAY. go for a walk and if you wanna write about something you saw, you can. or don't!

list your biggest regrets to date, flesh them out in lyric, and then burn them in the sink

write a poem in a fantasy world with at least one element of magic from the perspective of an inhabitant

write a poem about the time you should have said no and how it would have gone down

write about a way you show kindness without labelling it, just description

create a visual poem in the shape of the moon on the day you were born

write a poem thanking or exposing your anxieties and struggles

draw a plant and for the stem, write a micro-poem that centers your greatest strength as a stem

give your dreams a name and a number, then draw one at random and write it back from end to start

describe your superpower without naming it

think of your favourite song right now, pick one line, and use that as a start or finish to your poem

list the things you don't think you deserve. pick one and imagine receiving it. how would you feel?

write your anthem. sing your own praise. if you are a country, what is your song?
